## Cataract Surgery Post-operative Care & Advice





1 Apply eye drops (1 month)







2 Put on eye shield (while sleeping for 1 week)



3 Perform eye cleaning (1 week)



4 No food restrictions



**5** Allowed to travel



6 Able to drive (1 day after surgery or until your vision is clear or as advised by doctor)



Wear sunglasses when outdoors (1 week or longer if light sensitive)



8 Can watch TV



9 Can do computer work



10 Simple cooking is fine (no deep frying)



11 Can do near work (e.g. reading / writing / needlework)





12 Shower / bathe but avoid water entering eye



13 Gardening after 2 weeks



14 Use your eyes!



1 Don't rub / press on eye (1 month)



4 Avoid carrying young children who may accidentally poke your eye





3 Don't splash water into the eye (2 weeks)



5 Don't exercise (1 month)









6 Avoid sports (1 month)





7 Avoid swimming (1 month)



8 Don't lift heavy objects (1 month)



9 Avoid strenuous work (2-3 weeks)



10 Avoid wearing contact lens (1 month)



## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Glasses will be prescribed a month after operation.
- Following cataract operation (you may experience for a few days to a week):
  - Itchy / sticky eye / gritty feeling / "sandy" feeling and blurry vision.
  - Eye may be red or slight aching over eye area or bruising of the eye or eyelid.
- Whilst it may be normal to experience some flashes immediately after surgery and occasional floaters, a sudden significant increase in floaters should not be ignored but requires urgent medical attention.
- Should you experience or notice any of the following symptoms, please seek medical attention immedialely:
  - Pain not relieved by medication
  - Decrease in vision
  - Excessive discharge from operated eye
  - Sudden Increase of floaters or flashes
