
Laser Treatment Post-laser Care & Advice







Eye drops have been instilled in your eyes to dilate (enlarge) or constrict (shrink) your pupils to facilitate laser treatment.

Your vision may be blurred for up to 1 to 2 days* depending on the individual.





You may feel more comfortable using sunglasses if you experience any glare.





You should avoid driving after your laser treatment.

Have someone to accompany you home whenever possible.





You can take mild painkiller (e.g. Panadol) should you experience pain and headache.
