Synopsis

Patient is a 67 year-old man with right base of tongue cancer. He is being treated with chemo-radiation. He has history of diabetes on insulin and hypertension on dual anti-hypertensives. As a result of treatment, he had significant treatment related side effects, including poor oral intake due to nausea from chemo and pain from radiation treatment.

This patient was referred to family physician to manage his poorly controlled diabetes and low BP as a result of poor oral intake.
