## Need surgery? Here's what to expect

A guide to take you through a typical patient journey at SNEC from the time of your specialist consultation to post-operative discharge.

**ESTIMATED** 



You will need to go for pre-operative assessment:
• Electrocardiogram (ECG)

- Blood pressure
- Biometry (if lenses are required)
- Fasting instructions



When you need to do surgery, the doctor will explain:

- What the surgery is for, and if there are other options
- What outcome you can expect

You will be directed to 1C Pre-Surgery Services/Diabetes & Metabolism Centre (DMC) for financial counselling\*:

- Estimated total bill of the upcoming surgery
- Any out-of-pocket cash payment to be made

\*Patients at SNEC Eye Clinic @ Bedok and SNEC Eye Clinic @ SKH will have their financial counselling done at the respective clinics.



On the day of surgery, you should:
